Everyone is responsible for safety and has a duty to speak up for Veterans, Visitors and Staff. AFGE Local 910 continues to stand strong and deliver real results for the employees of the Kansas City VA. We believe in fair treatment, accountability, and justice in the workplace—and these recent victories prove that we never back down!

 <u>Victory in Arbitration</u>: Employee Wins Full Reasonable Accommodation Request
After a two-year battle, AFGE Local 910 secured a major arbitration win for an employee who was denied their reasonable accommodation request. The agency refused to comply, forcing the union to take
action. After arbitration, the employee prevailed and received every single accommodation they originally requested. This ruling is a huge win for disability rights and workplace fairness!

<u>Full Back Pay</u> for an Entire Work Group!

When a Step 3 grievance exposed the agency's failure to correctly code employee pay, AFGE Local 910 stepped in and fought back. We presented the necessary steps to fix the error and demanded accountability. The result? Every affected employee received the back pay they were owed!

Fighting for Fairness: Employee's Training & Equipment Secured
An employee who was placed on three months of Leave Without Pay (LWOP) due to a newly diagnosed disability was denied necessary training and equipment. AFGE Local 910 took immediate action and fought to ensure:

The employee's training time was paid
The agency provided essential work equipment
The employee was able to perform at a fully successful level
Another AFGE victory proving that we turn negatives into positives!
